BRIEF HISTORY AND REPORT OF EVANGELISTIC OUTREACH MINISTRIES

Evangelistic Outreach Ministries was incorporated as a religious nonprofit corporation in the state of Ohio on August 1, 1972. The ministry was approved as a tax exempt corporation by the Internal Revenue Service July 25, 1973.

Evangelistic Outreach is an interdenominational organization dedicated to the cause of "reaching the unreached" for Christ through radio, television, literature, revivals, crusades, special missionary projects, feeding hungry children, etc. And further to advance the cause of evangelism and Christian education; to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ; to seek the salvation of souls and to promote, cooperate and fellowship with all such churches and religious bodies having the same general objectives. And to promote Biblical, fundamental Christianity and to exalt the standards of Christian living in the community and to the world.

During the past year Evangelistic Outreach has:

- * Witnessed 739 public professions of faith making a total of 69,565 in the history of the ministry.
- * Conducted 64 revivals, crusades and camp meetings.
- * Conducted 347 additional special evangelistic services.
- * Conducted meetings in 125 different churches and schools.
- * Produced 260 -15 minute radio broadcasts.
- * Produced 52 - 30 minute television broadcasts.
- * Provided through correspondence, free Bible courses to over 739 active students in 3 countries.
- * Provided funds to train preachers and missionaries here in America to enter various fields of ministry and full time Christian service.
- * Maintained a website to post sermons, send information and to update supporters. There are also over 750 audio/text sermons available free of charge as a help to preachers, missionaries and others who minister all around the globe. A total of 484,897 sermons have been downloaded worldwide. Also, this includes podcasting capabilities at no charge to the users.
- * Gave partial support to a local church missions outreach project to provide for physical and spiritual care of the needy in the USA.
- * Provided food baskets for 2,247 families and 1,890 children were helped here in the USA. A total of 4,137 homes received varied assistance in the month of December alone. Many of those helped were veterans and their families.
- * Gave partial support to missionaries in Kenya who are caring for orphans and children in crisis at the Baby Center. They currently have 50 babies at this time in their facilities.

- They are operating at capacity and continue to need our support to maintain this level.
- * Gave partial support to the Good Shepherd Fold in East Africa who now have 102 children in their care. Many of these children are physically challenged. They also have a Primary School with over 300 students enrolled and it is a tremendous outreach in their community. The medical clinic now sees an average of over 100 patients each week.
 - * Gave partial support to ministries which assist people with drug, alcohol and substance abuse and shelter children in crisis as a result of these addictions. One facility currently houses 41 people recovering from substance abuse. This does not include those individuals now in transitional housing who have completed their program and are integrating back into communities with their families. Our ministry provided funds to help offset living expenses for residents in treatment.
 - * Provided partial support to other evangelistic ministries with like missions and/or goals.
 - * Our television and radio ministry is now aired on 29 stations and one national network (American Life Network). Also our programs can be downloaded at our website.
 - * Expanded support to Haitian pastors and missionaries who are planting churches in that nation along with a bakery to help feed orphans for free and provide jobs for church members. Have given record amounts of funding for Haitian Relief Project and have helped with the rebuilding of churches, schools and orphanages in that nation. We now help support or assist 80 churches and missions, 20 schools and 8 orphanages in this one nation.
 - * Provided funding for relief to churches and families in need here in the U.S.
 - * Expanded our distribution of Bibles, literature and sermons that are sent around the world with a total value of **\$314,887**. All materials are sent without cost.
 - * Printed and published the largest sermon book in the history of this ministry for free distribution.
 - * Built new churches overseas and helped with other church expansion projects. Also, provided funds to repair church structures in other countries.
 - * Gave partial support, materials and/or ministry assistance to native pastors and/or missionaries in 61 different countries.
 - * Provided funds to help churches continue to worship and rebuild due to catastrophic events. Gave financial assistance to mission churches planted in unchurched cities in the U.S.
 - * Supported widows in need of food, medicine, finances and temporary housing expense here in the U.S.
 - * 100 % of all support for missionary projects support is given to the designated cause without any administrative or handling costs. The ministry assumes all fund raising costs and does not deduct any amount from the missions giving received.

Our goal for the coming year is to continue to expand, as finances permit, our many programs and projects of missionary evangelism. We are a member of the National Religious Broadcasters Association. This ministry is governed by a Board of Trustees to maintain accountability and ensure the highest possible Christian ethics while pursuing the mission of ministry.
